

**WATER BOTTLES:**

Please send your student with a water bottle. For the health and safety of our staff and students as we continue to face a health crisis, our drinking fountains have been closed. However, we do have multiple water bottle refill stations available for student use.

**MASK'S:**

Students will wear masks at all times while on school property during the school day, regardless of vaccination status. Gators and scarves do not qualify as a mask. If a student wears a shield, they will also be expected to wear a mask.

**PARENTVUE:**

By using the Parentvue, it allows parent/guardians to check their student's progress regularly and stay up-to-date on assignments and due dates. If you do not have an activation key, please request one from the office.

**EARLY PICK UP:**

Parents are not allowed into the building. If you are picking up your student early, please call the school ten minutes before you arrive and we will call your student down from class. When you arrive, we will come outside where you can sign your student out.

A temperature over 100 degrees. Students are to remain home until they are fever free without the use of medication for 24 hours.

**MEDS:**

School personnel will assist students with prescription medication only if it's in the original container, properly labeled with dosage, & proper paperwork has been completed. Meds are stored in a locked cupboard in the health room
